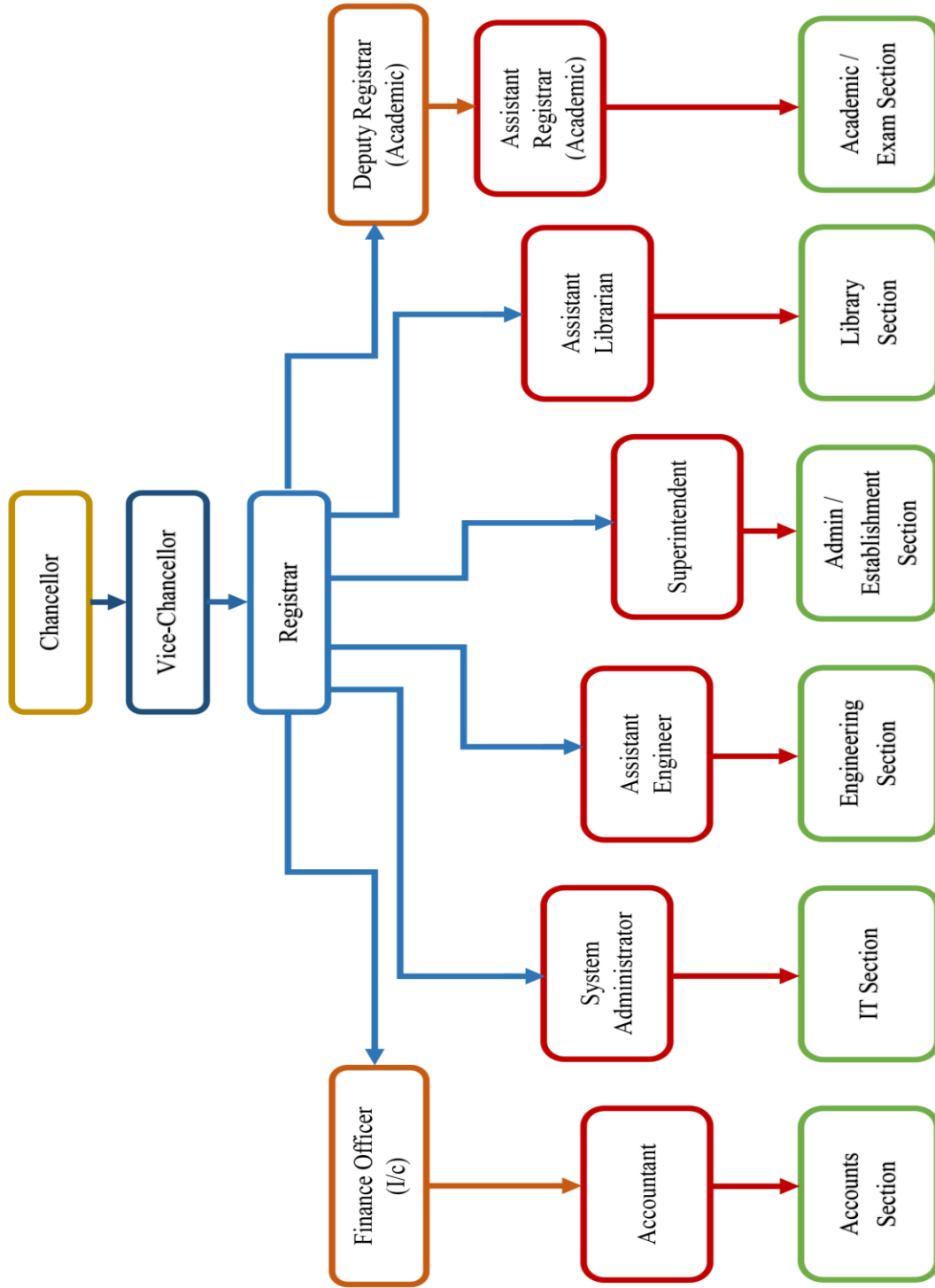
2. CHANCELLORS OF THE UNIVERSITY

The Committee undertakes surprise visits during examinations to keep a strict vigil on any unfair means and/ or malpractice adopted by the students. The University is equipped with Anti-Plagiarism Software which examines all the project reports and the dissertations submitted by the students. The software filters the contents of the project reports and the dissertations in accordance with the standards of National Law University, Assam Academic Misconduct Regulations.

4.4.3.3 The Internal Complaints Committee

The Internal Complains Committee (ICC) of the University has been constituted in accordance with the UGC (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher education institutions Women Employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2016 and looks into complaints, as and when received.

No case has been reported to ICC in the year 2022.

In order to beef-up on campus placement of students, a Placement Facilitation Committee has been set up by the University, which has mentored the outgoing batches. Several recruiters have evinced interest in visiting the University in order to conduct on premise placements.

Under the prevailing constraints, the University is endeavouring to create a vibrant online and offline placement mechanism.

7. CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE

7.1. Upcoming Projects

The second phase of campus infrastructure development has commenced with the approval of and financial assistance of INR 46 crores from the Government of Assam. Accordingly, the Public Works Department has started the second phase of construction of the following buildings:

A. 300 Bedded Student Hostel

The construction of a 300 bedded student hostel has commenced. The 300 bedded hostel is a six floor (G+5) building with 18000 square feet plinth area. The hostel building will consist of 150 single occupancy rooms and 90 double occupancy rooms along with a separate warden's room, warden office room, visitor's lounge, visitor's room, sick room, coffee shop, student mess, common room, study room etc. Washrooms will be constructed for the students at a ratio of 1:6. There will be four staircases and four lifts for the students along with the ramp at the entrance

B. Vice-Chancellors' Residence

The construction work for the residence of the Vice-Chancellor has started. The Vice-Chancellors' Residence is a duplex bungalow (G+1) with total area of 6250 square feet. The building will consist of four bedrooms, and a drawing cum dining room. There will be separate rooms for VC Office, caretaker, servant room, guest-room, waiting room etc. in the bungalow. The premise would also house a landscape garden.

C. Teachers' Residential Quarters

The construction of Teachers' Residential Quarters will commence shortly. The Teachers' Residential Quarters is modelled as a typical apartment building with 3000 square feet plinth area. Each quarter will be a three (03) bedroom flat with a common drawing and dining room, a kitchen, two (02) toilets and a balcony.

8. ACTIVITIES AND AMENITIES OF IT SECTION

8.1. Deployment of Next Generation Firewall

A Next Generation Firewall (NGFW) has been procured and deployed in the Campus to protect University's information assets to protect from cyber threats through the application of content inspection, cloud-based threat intelligence, and malicious software analysis etc. The system provides consistent protection and enhances the University's information security efforts.

8.2. Captive Portal-Based Internet Access System

To access Internet as well as other online resources in the campus, a new captive portal-based access system has been implemented. This system uses LDAP service for the authentication system.

8.3. VPN Service

A secure and user-friendly VPN service has been implemented for the users to access the online databases remotely.

8.4. Enhanced Wi-Fi Service at Hostels

New Access points have been procured and deployed in both hostels to enhance the Wi-Fi coverage. These high-end access points packed with the latest technology enable students to access online resources in more convenient way.

8.5. Deployment of SSL certificate

In order to keep user data secure, verify ownership of the website, prevent attackers, and also improve the overall performance of the University web servers, a wildcard SSL certificate has been procured and implemented on the university web servers.

8.6. OMR Software for Examination Section

A comprehensive OMR software is procured and deployment at the Examination Section. This software can facilitate the design of OMR questions, evaluate the result and generate various reports.

8.7. Online UPS Power Backup System at Academic Block

Two online UPS of capacity 10 KVA and 6 KVA have been installed at the Academic Block to provide power backup for the smart classrooms, ICT equipments as well as faculty chambers.

8.9. Upgradation and Renewal of Services

The following services were renewed for one year:

- Redhat Enterprise Linux Service Subscription.
- Google GSuite Enterprise for Education License.
- Licence of Payroll software system.

8.10. Facilitation of Online Admission Process

The Online Admission System developed by IT Section was implemented to facilitate admission of candidates, who have qualified the CLAT, 2022 and 2023 to the UG and PG Programmes at NLUJA, Assam.

8.11 Orientation/ Training

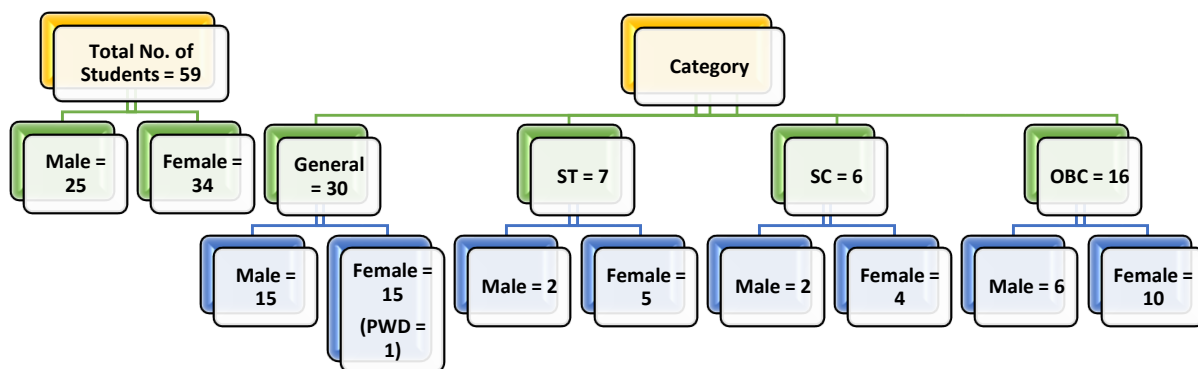

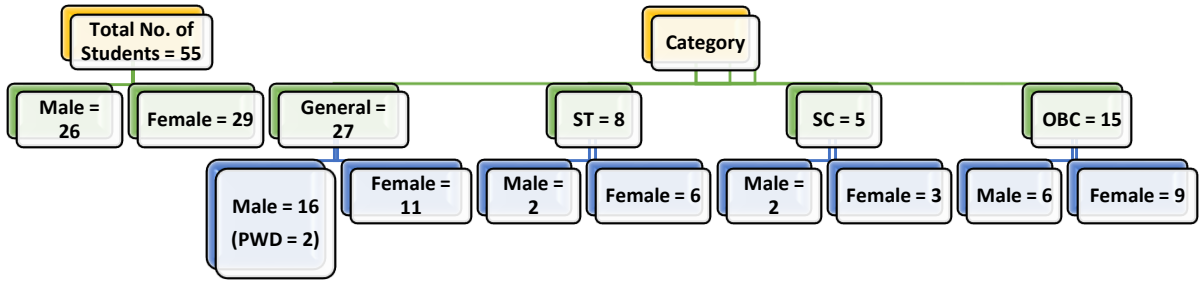

I-Year - 12th batch (2022-27)



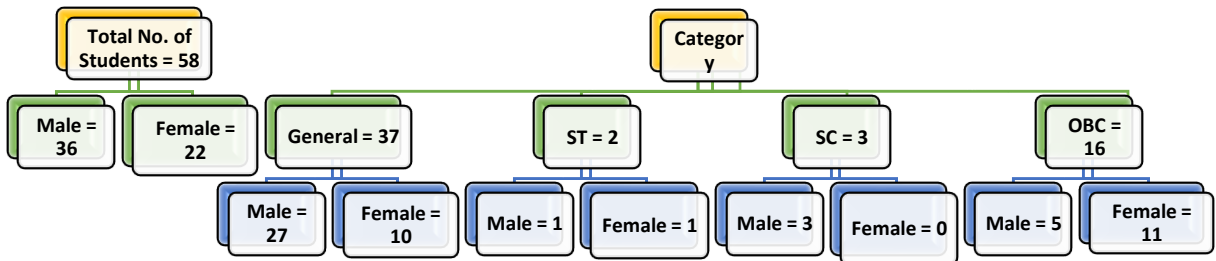

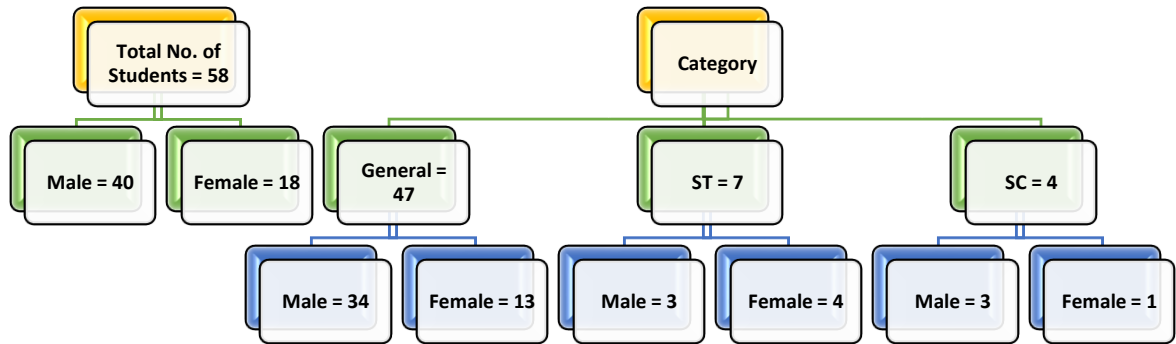

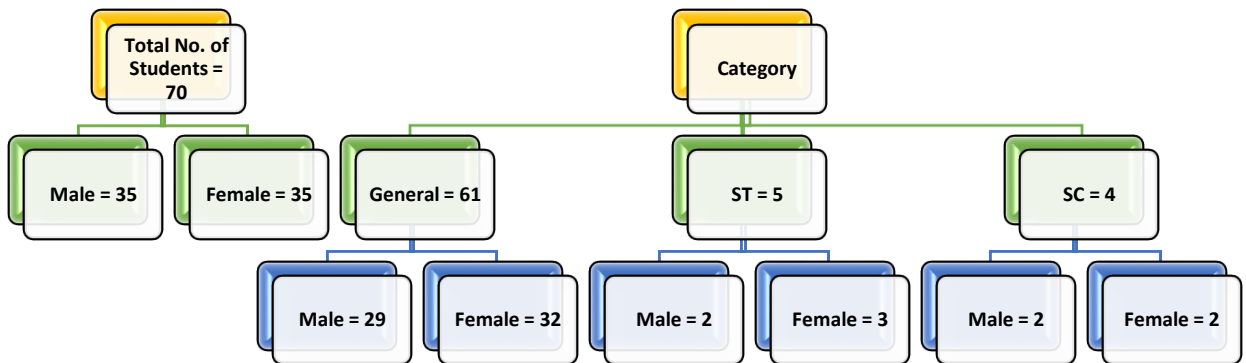

Approx. 50,000 candidates appeared for online test. Out of the successful candidates 60 (Sixty) students got admitted to the B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) Five Year Integrated Course at National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam.

An Online Orientation Programme was held for the newly admitted students with their parents / guardians. The programme was presided over by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. V. K. August 13, 2022 - Rangoli Competition

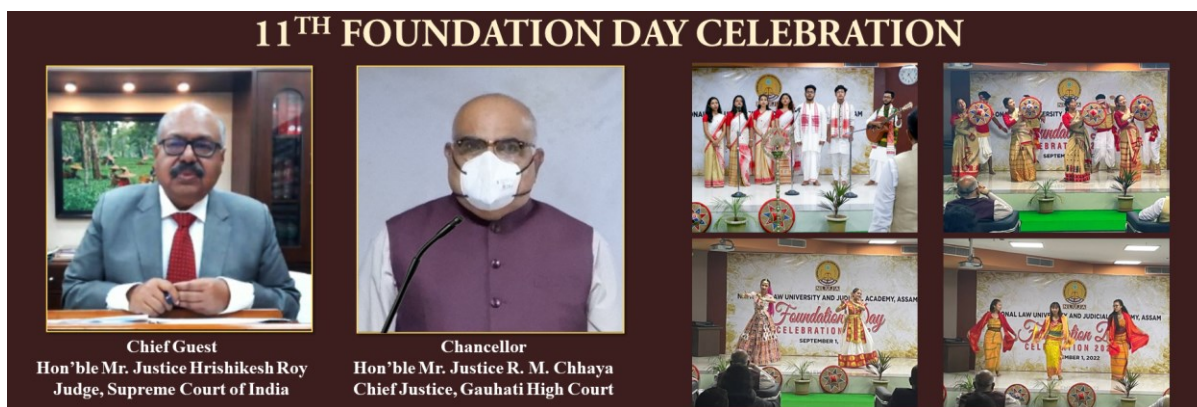

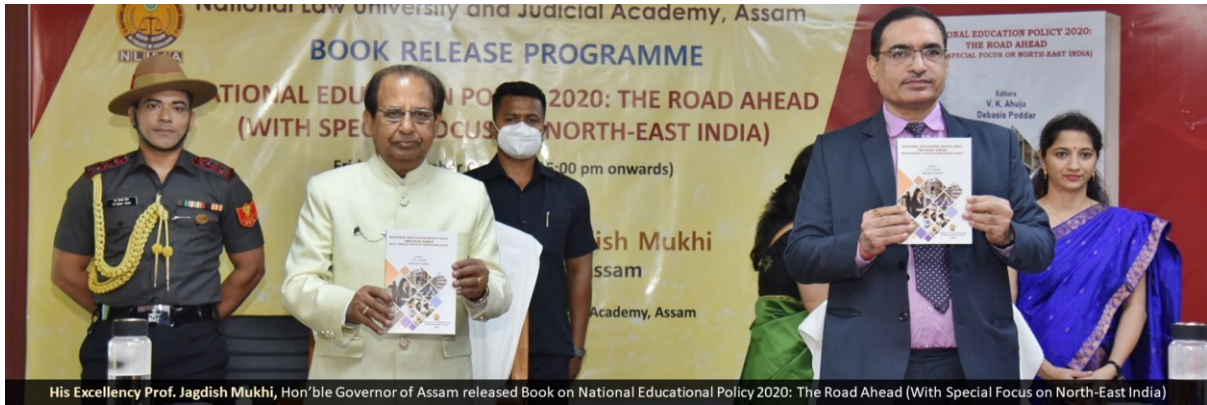
