Terms and Conditions:

1. The rates should be quoted as shown against the items/works should be inclusive of all GST/taxes applicable at any point of time.
2. The sealed envelope should have the following inscription on top as "National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam".
3. The Quotationer will have to deposit earnest money of **Rs. 10,000/-** in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Registrar, National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam.
4. Each dealer/firm/individual must have Authorization Certificate from OEM, GST Registration, Trade License, PAN Card, Income Tax Clearance Certificate. A copy of the same must be submitted along with the Quotation/Tender.
5. Bills must be submitted along with necessary work order and a copy of Challan etc. within seven days from the date of delivery of service for payment failing which no payment shall be made.
6. In case lowest rate is quoted by one firm for some items and by other firms for other items then the selected firm will have to give the assurance/consent letter to supply any or all of the materials as mentioned above, as per approved rates of the undersigned.
7. Any firm/supplier indulging in any malpractice or adopting any unfair means will be barred from undertaking any work with the University.
