

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF PROFESSOR, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR, ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF LAW. *

I. PROFESSOR (2- UR Positions)

SCALE OF PAY: Rs. 37400-67000 (PB-4) AGP Rs. 10000

- 1) a) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research / policy papers.
- b) A minimum of ten years' experience in University / College, and /or experience in research at the University / National level institutions / industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- c) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- d) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

OR

An outstanding professional, with an exceptional accomplishment established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned / allied / relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

II. ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (3 Positions: 1-UR, 1-OBC, 1-SC)

SCALE OF PAY: Rs. 37400-67000 (PB-4) AGP Rs. 9000

- a) Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned / allied / relevant disciplines.
- b) A Master's degree in Law with at least 55% of marks / 50% of marks for SC / ST candidates (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- c) A minimum of eight years' experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/ College or Accredited Research Institution/ Industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and / or research / policy papers.
- d) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching/learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students, as evidenced by Ph.D. thesis / co-authored books / publications in peer reviewed journals.
- e). A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS)

* Minimum qualification subject to changes in concurrence with UGC regulations issued from time to time.

**III. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (2 Positions: 1-OBC, 1-SC)
SCALE OF PAY: Rs. 15600-39100 (PB-3) AGP Rs. 6000**

- a) Good academic record with at least 55% marks / 50% marks for SC/ST candidates (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- b) The candidate should have cleared National Eligibility Test (NET) / Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009.

Note:

A relaxation of 5% will be provided (from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D.) degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
