## Centre for Clinical Legal Education and Legal Aid Cell NLUJAA

On 25th March 2025, the Centre for Clinical Legal Education and Legal Aid Cell (CCLELAC) organised a community outreach program to make the local residents aware of the services provided by the Legal Aid Clinic of NLUJAA. The purpose of the campaign was to have direct interaction with the local people and inform them about the presence of the Legal Aid Clinic and how we may help them. We also asked the residents the legal problems they usually face. Some of them shared their legal issues related to domestic violence and accident-claims. We told them the legal recourse available in such cases. We also got to meet a social worker in that area. He was glad to see us there. We told him how we can work together and spread legal awareness in the area and help people. Overall, the interaction with the people and the drive was successful. The volunteers could communicate in Assamese and Hindi both, and therefore, the interaction with the villagers was meaningful.
